Pronunciation

For the most part one Russian letter corresponds to one sound. **Ë** is always stressed. **O** is pronounced **a** if unstressed: молоко - [малако] *milk*. E is pronounced и if unstressed: менеджер - [мениджир] manager. Ending -го is always pronounced -во: его - [ево] his, him. When consonants appear at the end of a word, they lose their voice. б is pronounced like п: клуб - [клуп] club в is pronounced like ф: Медведев - [мидведеф] Medvedev (a surname) г is pronounced like к: маркетинг - [маркитинк] marketing д is pronounced like т: шоколад - [шакалат] chocolate ж is pronounced like ш: ложь - [лош] lie з is pronounced like с: каприз - [каприс] caprice




